

Admission Arrangement

The Central Counting Station (“CCS”) will be set up at the AsiaWorld-Expo (“AWE”), Chek Lap Kok. Members of the public will be able to observe the counting of votes at the public galleries inside the Media Centre (“MC”), Hall 1 and Hall 5 and to watch the announcement of election results at the public gallery inside the MC.

Owing to the limited area of the public galleries, members of the public are required to put on a wristband provided by the Registration and Electoral Office at the point of admission at the Central Concourse, 1/F of the AWE, for identification purpose. A total of 1,200 wristbands will be distributed on a “first-come, first-served” basis starting from 11:00 p.m. on 4 September while stock lasts.

Please note the following admission arrangements before entering the CCS -

- (i) Members of the public are required to observe the House Rules and go through the bag search before admission.
- (ii) After the bag search, security guards will put on wristbands for members of the public at the point of admission.
- (iii) Members of the public are required to wear the wristbands inside the CCS and should keep them in good condition for identification and re-entry purpose.
- (iv) When re-entering the CCS, members of the public are required to go through the bag search again.
- (v) When leaving the CCS with NO intention of re-entering the venue, please inform the security guards to cut the wristbands.
- (vi) No replacement for any lost or damaged wristbands can be arranged.
