Admission Arrangement for the Central Counting Station

The Central Counting Station ("CCS") of the Fifth Term Chief Executive Election will be set up at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre ("HKCEC"), Wanchai. Members of the public may enter the public gallery within the CCS to observe the counting of votes and the announcement of election result.

Owing to the limited area of the public gallery, the seating capacity is limited to 1 000. Members of the public are required to wear a wristband provided by the Registration and Electoral Office at the point of admission at Hall 3F, 3/F of the HKCEC, for identification purpose. Member of the public will be admitted to the venue via the Harbour Road Entrance and a total of 1 000 wristbands will be distributed at the point of admission on a "first-come, first-served" basis starting from 10:00 a.m. on 26 March 2017, while stock lasts.

Please note the following admission arrangements before entering the CCS -

- 1. Members of the public are required to observe the House Rules and go through the bag search process before admission.
- 2. After the bag search process, security guards will put on wristbands for members of the public.
- 3. Members of the public are required to wear the wristbands within the CCS for identification and re-entry purpose.
- 4. Members of the public are required to go through the bag search process again upon re-entering the CCS.
- 5. When leaving the CCS with NO intention of re-entry, please inform the security guards at the exit of the CCS who will assist you to remove the wristbands.
- 6. No replacement for any lost or damaged wristbands will be arranged.
