

Admission Arrangement for the Central Counting Station (“CCS”)

The CCS of 2016 Election Committee Subsector Elections will be set up at the AsiaWorld-Expo (“AWE”), Chek Lap Kok. Election Committee (“EC”) members and members of the public will be able to observe the counting of votes and the announcement of election results at the Media Centre (“MC”) inside the CCS.

EC Members (including the Hong Kong deputies to the National People's Congress, Legislative Council members and members of the Religious Subsector)

EC Members may enter the “Candidates and Agents Area” inside the MC to observe the counting of votes and the announcement of election results. Upon arrival at the CCS, they need to proceed to the designated registration counter at the Central Concourse, 1/F of the AWE and present their Hong Kong Identity cards to counter staff. After verification, they will receive an identification name badge. After getting the name badge, they have to go through the bag search process before entering or re-entering the CCS.

Members of the Public

Members of the public may enter the public gallery inside the MC to observe the counting of votes and the announcement of election results. Owing to the limited area of the public gallery inside the MC, members of the public are required to put on a wristband provided by the Registration and Electoral Office at the point of admission at the Central Concourse, 1/F of the AWE, for identification purpose. A total of 700 wristbands will be distributed on a “first-come, first-served” basis starting from 11:00 p.m. on 11 December 2016, while stock lasts.

All persons who enter the CCS should note the following admission arrangements -

- (i) to observe the House Rules and go through the bag search process before admission;
- (ii) to put on the name badges/wristbands, as appropriate, when entering and staying in the CCS and should keep the name

badges/wristbands in good condition for identification and re-entry purpose;

- (iii) to go through the bag search process again upon re-entering the CCS;
- (iv) when leaving the CCS with NO intention of re-entry, for EC members, please place the name badges in the collection box at the exit of the CCS. As for members of the public, please inform the security guards at the exit of the CCS who will assist you to remove the wristbands; and
- (v) no replacement for any lost or damaged wristbands will be arranged.
