## 2016 Election Committee Subsector Elections Arrangement for Depositing and Claiming Items in the Central Counting Station("CCS")

According to the 2016 Election Committee Subsector Elections House Rules of the CCS, No. (6)–

"To keep order at the CCS, ensure public safety and ensure the proper and smooth conduct of the counting of votes, no person shall bring into the CCS, or use or display in the CCS, any article which may cause any nuisance, inconvenience, disturbance, obstruction or danger to other persons (including loudhailers), without the prior permission of the Chief Returning Officer (Subsectors) or the Returning Officer in charge of that counting zone. The staff of the Registration and Electoral Office or AsiaWorld-Expo may inspect the personal belongings of persons seeking entry to or at the CCS to ensure compliance with the above rules."

Therefore, as far as practicable, persons visiting the CCS should deposit the items in the cloak rooms located at 1/F, Central Concourse or Hall 11. The arrangements are as follows—

- 1. Please follow the instructions given by the security guards for registering the deposit items.
- 2. After registration, persons visiting the CCS will be given a number tag.
- 3. Persons visiting the CCS have to present this number tag when claiming the items. Please keep the number tag in good condition.
- 4. Persons visiting the CCS are reminded to claim their personal belongings kept in the cloak rooms before leaving the CCS.
- 5. As the cloak rooms would be closed in 30 minutes after the end of the event, persons visiting the CCS should claim their items as soon as possible after the end of the event.
