EXPLANATORY NOTES ON COMPLETION OF AN APPEAL NOTICE

1. A person claiming to be a candidate at a subsector election may appeal to the Revising Officer against the result of that subsector election by lodging an appeal notice using this specified form.

2. An appeal notice may be lodged to question a subsector election only on the ground that the person declared by the Returning Officer in accordance with the regulations made under the Electoral Affairs Commission to have been elected as a member of the Election Committee at the subsector election was not duly elected because—

- (a) the person was ineligible to be, or was disqualified from being, a candidate at the subsector election; or
- (b) material irregularity occurred in relation to the subsector election, or to the polling or counting of votes at the subsector election.
- 3. An appellant must furnish his/her particulars at the space provided in this appeal notice.

4. An appellant must deliver the appeal notice <u>in person</u> to the Registry for Appeals to Revising Officer ("Appeal Registry") at the following address:

5. An appeal notice may be lodged to the Revising Officer only after the date on which the Returning Officer has published in the Gazette the result being appealed against and must reach the Revising Officer not later than 7 days after that date. For the purpose of illustration,

- On or before 2 September 2021 for an appeal in relation to the election result for the relevant uncontested subsector election (assuming that the election result is published in the Gazette on 26 August 2021); or
- On or before 30 September 2021 for an appeal in relation to the election result for the relevant contested subsector election (assuming that the election result is published in the Gazette on 23 September 2021).

6. The Revising Officer will send by post a notice to the appellant and the person whose election is questioned specifying the date, time and place fixed for such hearing. Both the appellant and the person whose election is questioned may appear at the hearing either in person or be represented by a legal practitioner or any other person (authorized in writing). Whether or not the appellant appears or is represented at the hearing, he/she may make representations in writing and submit them, by post or by hand, which should reach the Revising Officer on a date at least one clear day before the date fixed for the hearing. This arrangement also applies to the person whose election is questioned.

7. If the appellant does not appear or is not represented at the hearing, or if the Revising Officer does not receive any representations in writing from the appellant on a date at least one clear day before the date of the hearing, the result of the subsector election to which the appeal notice relates shall stand.

8. These notes are for general guidance only. An appellant should also refer to the Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569) and subsidiary legislation made thereunder. An appellant can visit the website: https://www.elegislation.gov.hk/.
