

Preventive Measures and Crowd Management
for Appeal Hearing Venue
of the 2021 Election Committee Subsectors Ordinary Elections

Having regard to the prevailing public health situation, all persons attending Election Committee Subsector Ordinary Elections Appeal hearing (including review hearing) are subject to the following preventive measures and crowd management arrangements:

- i. all persons, including parties and legal representatives, who are subject to any quarantine requirement or medical surveillance of the Government should not come to the hearing venues to attend the hearings. They should inform the Registry for Appeals to Revising Officer as soon as practicable with reasons for absence as appropriate;
 - ii. all persons are required to undergo body temperature check and wear a surgical mask before they are allowed to enter and remain in the hearing venues. Any person who has a fever / refuses to undergo body temperature check / does not wear a surgical mask will be refused entry into or directed to leave the hearing venues;
 - iii. to maintain social distancing, the seating capacity of hearing venues and waiting rooms are reduced by about 50%. In addition, capacity limits are set for registration areas of the hearing venues to avoid crowding of people; and
 - iv. all persons should maintain good personal hygiene at all times and disinfect their hands frequently during their stay in the hearing venues. Alcohol-based handrub is provided at the registration areas of the hearing venues.
2. Queuing and other crowd management measures that are necessary to support the above arrangements, as well as security controls to limit the

number of people entering and remaining in the hearing venues, will be put in place as appropriate.

3. All persons attending the hearings are strongly advised to check the updated information from the website of the Registry for Appeals to Revising Officer (<https://www.elections.gov.hk/ecss2021/eng>), and follow the advice of the Registry staff and security personnel when they attend the hearings.
