

Timetable for Posting Free Postage Election Mail **2026 Election Committee Subsector Ordinary Elections**

Key dates	Procedures
7 October– 9 November 2026 (except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday)	Candidates can submit their specimens of postage-free election mail at any one of the following Hongkong Post offices:- ● General Post Office, Central ● G/F, Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay ● 10/F, Tsuen Wan Government Offices, Tsuen Wan ● 1/F, Sha Tin Government Offices, Sha Tin <u>Remarks :</u> (1) Under the prevailing legislation, letters that may be posted free of postage <u>must not be larger than 165 mm x 245 mm</u> in size and <u>must not exceed 5 mm in thickness at any part of the letter;</u> (2) To save time, candidates may consider submitting their specimen(s) of postage-free election mail before being assigned with candidate number or confirming the printing details of the election mail; and (3) Once the specimen(s) concerned has/have been approved in writing by Hongkong Post, candidates may insert the candidate number or printing details into that election mail <u>without altering the approved design and content of the election mail.</u>
7 October– 12 November 2026 (except Sunday and public holiday)	Candidates can post postage-free election mail at any one of the 17 designated acceptance offices. (For details, please refer to the <u>Appendix II</u> of “Notes on Posting Free Postage Election Mail”.) <u>Remarks :</u> (1) Candidates must select one of the acceptance offices to post their postage-free election mail when handing in the specimen(s) and “Notice of Posting Free Postage Election Mail” to Hongkong Post; and (2) Candidates must furnish the Postmaster General with a security (i.e. full postage of all the election mail posted) if postings of their postage-free election mail are made before the publication of notice of valid nominations in the Gazette.
