	(2) Once the specimens concerned have been approved in writing by Hongkong Post, candidates may insert the candidate/list number or printing details into the election mail without altering the approved design and text of the election mail. There is no need for candidates to re-submit the revised specimens to Hongkong Post for approval.
16 January – 28 February 2018	Candidates can post postage-free election mail at any one of 18 designated post offices / delivery offices.
