

Admission Arrangement for the Central Counting Station

The Central Counting Station (“CCS”) of the 2018 Legislative Council By-election will be set up at Halls 5F and 5G of the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre (“HKCEC”), Wanchai. Members of the public may enter the public gallery within the CCS to observe the counting of votes and the announcement of election result.

Owing to the limited area of the public gallery, the seating capacity is limited to 800. Members of the public are required to wear a wristband provided by the Registration and Electoral Office at the point of admission at Hall 5E, 5/F of the HKCEC, for identification purpose. Members of the public will be admitted to the venue via the Harbour Road Entrance and a total of 800 wristbands will be distributed at the point of admission on a “first-come, first-served” basis starting from 11:00 p.m. on 11 March 2018, while stock lasts.

Please note the following admission arrangements before entering the CCS –

1. Members of the public are required to observe the House Rules and go through the metal detector and bag search process before admission.
2. After the above process, security guards will put on wristbands for members of the public.
3. Members of the public are required to wear the wristbands within the CCS for identification and re-entry purpose.
4. Members of the public are required to go through the metal detector and bag search process again upon re-entering the CCS.
5. When leaving the CCS with NO intention of re-entry, please inform the security guards at the exit of the CCS who will assist you to remove the wristbands.
6. No replacement for any lost or damaged wristbands will be arranged.
