<u>2018 Legislative Council</u> <u>Kowloon West Geographical Constituency By-election</u> <u>Arrangement for depositing and claiming items in Media Centre</u>

According to 2018 Legislative Council Kowloon West Geographical Constituency By-election House Rules of Media Centre ("MC"), No. (4) –

"no person shall bring into, use or display in the Media Centre any article which may cause any nuisance, inconvenience, disturbance, interference, obstruction or danger to other persons (including loudhailers, umbrellas etc.) or publicity materials of any kind (including banners, bunting flyers etc.), or distribute in the Media Centre any promotional materials, souvenirs or give-away items without the prior permission of REO¹. The staff of REO or officer authorised by REO have the authority to inspect the personal belongings of persons seeking entry to or at the Media Centre to ensure compliance with the above rules."

Therefore, any person before entering the MC should deposit the aforesaid items, if any, at the Counter for Depositing Items ("the Counter") located at the Tiu Keng Leng Sports Centre. The arrangements are as follows –

- 1. Please follow the instructions given by the security guards for registering the items to be deposited.
- 2. After registration, persons visiting the MC will be given a number tag.
- 3. Persons visiting the MC will be required to present this number tag when claiming the items. Please keep the number tag in good condition.
- 4. Persons visiting the MC are reminded to claim their items kept at the Counter before leaving the MC.
- 5. As the Counter would be closed in 30 minutes after the end of the event, persons visiting the MC should claim their items as soon as possible after the end of the event.
