

**2021 Legislative Council General Election**  
**Arrangement for Depositing and Claiming Items**  
**in Central Counting Station**

According to 2021 Legislative Council General Election House Rules of Central Counting Station (“CCS”), No. (5) –

“A person shall not bring into, use or display in the CCS any article which may cause any nuisance, inconvenience, disturbance, interference, obstruction or danger to other persons (including but not limited to articles as stipulated in the Reference List of Prohibited Articles) or distribute in the CCS any promotional materials, souvenirs or give-away items without the prior permission of the CRO<sup>1</sup> or the RO<sup>2</sup> in charge of that counting zone. The staff of the Registration and Electoral Office or the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre have the authority to inspect the personal belongings of persons seeking entry to or at the CCS. If any prohibited articles are found, the relevant person will be asked to deposit such items at the cloak room, or the person must leave the CCS immediately to ensure compliance with the above rules.”

Therefore, any person before entering the CCS should deposit the aforesaid items, if any, in the cloak rooms located at the Chancellor Room, 4/F (for Members of the Public only) or Hall 5E, 5/F (for Candidates and Agents only). The arrangements are as follows –

1. Please follow the instructions given by the security guards for registering the items to be deposited.
2. After registration, persons visiting the CCS will be given a number tag.
3. Persons visiting the CCS will be required to present this number tag when claiming the items. Please keep the number tag in good condition.
4. Persons visiting the CCS are reminded to claim their items kept in the cloak rooms before leaving the CCS.
5. As the cloak room will be closed in 30 minutes after the end of the event, persons visiting the CCS should claim their items as soon as possible after the end of the event.
