選舉事務處會設立一個專供選舉委員會（選委會）界別使用的投票站，讓選委會委員在同一投票站內投下2021年立法會換屆選舉選委會界別、地方選區和功能界別（如適用）的選票。

日期：2021年12月19日（星期日）
投票時間：早上8時30分至晚上10時30分
投票站地址：香港會議展覽中心（會展）1樓會議廳

填劃選票

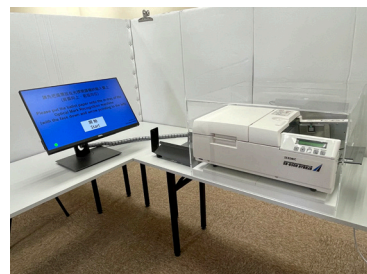
選委會界別選票

- 選民**必須**投選全數40名候選人，否則選票即告無效，不予點算
- 選民使用投票站提供的黑色筆，**填滿**選票上所選擇候選人姓名旁的**橢圓圈**
- 填劃選票後，建議選民使用裝設於近投票站出口的光學標記閱讀機，檢查選票上所選取的候選人數目是否40名。光學標記閱讀機不會記錄選票上的選擇。如有需要，可向工作人員求助
- 選民如錯誤填劃選票，可將選票交回投票站主任，並要求換取另一張未經填劃的選票
- 選民將填好的選票放進投票站提供的封套，再放入**白色**投票箱。**切勿**摺疊選票及封套

地方選區及功能界別選票

- 選民分別在地方選區及功能界別的選票上，在所選擇的候選人姓名旁的圓圈內用投票站提供的印章蓋上1個「✓」號（勞工界功能界別最多可選擇3名候選人）
- 選民應把選票正面向下，將地方選區選票放入**藍色**投票箱；功能界別選票放入**紅色**投票箱

特別隊伍

投票站設立特別隊伍，方便以下選民領取選票：

- 年滿70歲或以上人士；
- 孕婦；或
- 因身體狀況而難以長時間站立或難以排隊的人士

防疫措施

- 選民必須佩戴口罩、量度體溫、消毒雙手及保持社交距離
- 有發燒 / 呼吸道感染徵狀的選民會被引領到特別投票間投票

點票

- 投票結束後，選委會界別和功能界別的投票箱會運往設於會展3樓的中央點票站
- 選委會界別選票會在光學標記閱讀系統輔助下自動點算；功能界別則以人手點票
- 選委會界別投票站的地方選區點票工作會於選票分流站按地方選區分類，並與大點票站的選票混合後以人手進行
- 完成點票程序後，選舉主任會在中央點票站的新聞中心正式宣布選舉結果

2021 Legislative Council General Election

Election Committee Constituency Introduction on voting procedures

The Registration and Electoral Office will set up an Election Committee Constituency (ECC) polling station for ECC electors to cast their ECC, Geographical Constituency (GC) and Functional Constituency (FC) (if any) votes of the 2021 Legislative Council General Election.

Date: December 19, 2021 (Sunday)
Polling hours: 8:30am – 10:30pm
Polling station address: Convention Hall, 1/F, Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre (HKCEC)

Polling Obtaining ballot papers

- Electors will be directed to a ballot paper issuing desk in the polling station
- Electors to present the Hong Kong Identity Card to the staff and pull aside the mask temporarily as instructed
- Staff will use the Electronic Poll Register system to verify electors' identity and then issue the ballot papers
- Electors should immediately proceed to a voting compartment to mark the ballot papers by themselves

Marking ballot papers

ECC ballot paper

- Electors **must** vote for 40 candidates, no more and no less. Otherwise, the ballot paper will be considered invalid and will not be counted
- Electors to use the black pen provided by the polling station to **fill in** the **oval** opposite the names of the candidates of their choice
- Electors are encouraged to use an Optical Mark Recognition (OMR) machine installed near the exit of the polling station, after marking the ballot paper, to check whether the number of candidates marked on the ballot paper is 40. The machine **will not** record the choices marked on the ballot paper. If necessary, electors may seek help from staff
- If there is an error in marking the ballot paper, electors may return that ballot paper to the Presiding Officer and ask for another unmarked ballot paper
- Electors to insert the ballot paper into the envelope provided by the polling station and put it into the **white** ballot box. Do **not** fold the envelope or the ballot paper

GC and FC ballot papers

- Electors to affix the chop provided by the polling station to mark a single “✓” in the circle opposite the name of the candidate of their choice on the GC and FC ballot papers respectively (up to 3 candidates in the case of the Labour FC)
- With the marked side facing down, electors to insert the GC ballot paper into the **blue** ballot box while the FC ballot paper into the **red** ballot box

Special queue

A special queue will be set up at the polling station to facilitate the following electors for obtaining ballot papers:

- persons aged 70 or above;
- pregnant women; or
- persons who are not able to stand for a long time or have difficulty in queuing due to their physical condition

Anti-epidemic measures

- Electors must wear masks, have their body temperature checked, sanitise their hands, and keep social distance
- Electors with fever/respiratory symptoms will be directed to a special voting compartment to vote

Counting

- After the close of the poll, ballot boxes of the ECC and FC will be delivered to the central counting station (CCS) on 3/F of the HKCEC
- Vote counting for the ECC will be conducted in an automated mode with the aid of the OMR machines, while the FC votes will be counted manually
- Vote counting for the GC will be conducted manually after sorting by GCs at the ballot paper sorting station and then delivered to the respective main counting stations for mixing with other ballot papers
- Upon completion of the counting procedures, the Returning Officers will formally announce the election results at the media centre in the CCS
